PARTICIPATION IN PRESCHOOL PROGRAMS

The Board of Education recognizes its responsibility in ensuring that all resident pre-school children with disabilities have the opportunity to participate in special programs and services. In the unlikely event students requiring pre-school special education services reside within the District, the Board directs the Superintendent to establish administrative practices and procedures to ensure the timely evaluation and placement of such students, including the establishment of a Committee on Pre-School Special Education (CPSE), subject to the requirements of Policy # 4321.5 (parental consent). In the event a preschool student with a disability resides in the District, the Superintendent shall prepare a list of all preschool programs within Westchester County, which will be available to the Parent (as that term is defined in Policy # 4321) of a pre-school student with a disability at the student's initial CPSE meeting and in the District's office for Special Education.
