**Expectations for Student Dress and Appearance**

The Greenburgh Eleven UFSD is committed to appropriate student dress and appearance. The Dress for Success Program is part of our District Code of Conduct. It is a standard of clothing that has been implemented to help the student prepare for the world of work as well as raise student's self esteem. The minimum standard consists of the following:

Students will wear a collared "golf shirt with "khaki"/chino/Docker style pants/shorts. Jeans (denim pants of any kind) or t-shirts are not permitted.

Students will not be permitted to wear the following on campus: do-rags, bandanas, head sweatband, etc, beads of any kind, facial piercings of any kind.

Students are permitted to wear hats to the campus, but they must be worn in a forward direction and they must remove them once they enter any building, hats will be confiscated if students do not comply with this rule.
