Emmanuel Glasu, Director of Finances and Grants Administration reported that June 2020 enrollment, at 155 FTEs, was .75 FTEs lower than May 2020 enrollment. Average enrollment at the end of June 2020 was 1.44 FTEs higher than May 2020. The current average enrollment deficit of 15.92 FTEs will result in a revenue shortfall of \$ 1.18 Million at the tuition rate included in the 2019-2020 budget.
